Handicap Committee Update

In 2006, the USGA established a set of criteria golf clubs are required to meet in order to be licensed to issue members a USGA Handicap Index. Included is a requirement to establish reasonable procedures and checks to insure members are accurately posting all home and away scores. Whether OCC has a problem with sandbaggers and ego handicaps will forever be debated in the Grill Room. Either way, our club has a responsibility to establish handicap procedures that will instill confidence that handicaps issued by OCC accurately reflect our members' playing ability.

The following are some of the policies that will be in effect for 2011.

Club Events: A valid USGA Handicap will be required to participate in all NET club events. See the golf shop to setup a new handicap. (5) scores are needed to generate your initial handicap index.

Posting of Scores: It is each player's responsibility to insure all home and away scores are entered on OCC's handicap system. Scores can be entered directly using the Club's handicap computer, or via the internet (use the handicap posting section of the Iowa State Golf Association's web site at www.iowagolf.org)

Adjusted Gross Scores: Players must enter *Adjusted Gross Scores*. All scores, including tournament scores, are subject to adjustment through the application of Equitable Stroke Control (ESC). ESC reduces high hole scores for handicap purposes in order to make handicaps more representative of a player's potential ability. If members enter hole-by-hole scores on one of OCC's handicap computers, the system will automatically adjust the player's score. Otherwise, the player must adjust their score using the guidelines set forth in the table below.

<u>Course Handicap</u>	<u>Maximum Number on any Hole</u>
9 or less	Double Bogey
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or more	10

Partial Rounds: If 13 or more holes are played, the player must post an 18-hole score. If 7-12 holes are played, the player must post a nine-hole score. In either case, scores for unplayed holes must be recorded as par plus any handicap strokes that the player is entitled to receive on the unplayed holes.

Tournament Scores: When a player plays in a competition organized and conducted by a committee in charge of the competition, and the competition is played under the principles of the *Rules of Golf*, the player's score must be identified as a *tournament score* when entered. For tournaments played at OCC, players must turn in a score card and the Golf Shop staff will be responsible for entering the tournament scores.

Season Long Match Play Tournaments (President's Cup): Players are required to turn in a card to the golf shop and it will be posted as a Tournament Score.
